Scholarship Application and Eligibility Requirements

All applicants are considered regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, or gender.

Eligibility:

Any student currently attending or planning to attend the Gila Community College (GCC) who is working toward a certificate or a degree may apply. Students must be registered in at least twelve (12 credits) and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Application Deadline:

All Completed Scholarship applications must be postmarked or delivered no later than August 21, 2025 for Fall 2025 and October 1, for Spring 2026 term. Applications received after either of these dates will only be considered under special circumstances and if funding is available.



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Selections Process:

All applicants will receive consideration for scholarships based on:

1. Being a US Citizen
2. Be able to demonstrate financial need: have applied to FASFA and have an award amount/letter to attach to the application and completed the financial section of the application.
3. Be enrolled as a student in an undergraduate program.
4. Provide proof you attended and graduated from Globe High School or Miami High School, or Payson High School.
5. Have not earned an undergraduate (bachelor's degree) yet or are part of a qualified post baccalaureate teacher's training program.
6. Scholarship recipients receiving a need-based academic scholarship will be required to write a thank you letter to the anonymous donor and
7. Provide a current photo of themselves in order to be considered for future semester needs.
